There are benefits to traders who register under the Motor Vehicle Sales Act 2003 (MVSA). Some of the benefits of registration are:

- you are no longer restricted to selling from specified premises
- your salespersons are not required to be registered or approved
- there is no compulsory membership in any trade association
- there are no special warranties in addition to the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993
- there is no fidelity fund.

Renew my registration

As a registered motor vehicle trader, you must renew your registration every year prior to it expiring. Renewing your registration can be done online at anytime - 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
